


ALASKA: ECE PUBLIC SPENDING 2022

ECE and K-12

For every dollar spent on K-12 in Alaska, 6 cents are spent on 0 to 3-year-olds, and 8 cents on 3 to 5.5-year-olds.

Total Number of Children Age 0 to 3: 28,560

Total Number of Children Age 3 to K-entry: 25,312

Total Number of Children K-entry & up: 129,562

Total ECE Spending: \$77 Million

Total Expenditures by Age

0 to 3 Spending: \$33 Million
 3 to K-entry Spending: \$43 Million
 K-12 Spending: \$2.6 Billion

 Actual State & Federal Expenditures: \$76.7 Million
