


FLORIDA: ECE PUBLIC SPENDING 2022

ECE and K-12

For every dollar spent on K-12 in Florida, 12 cents are spent on 0 to 3-year-olds, and 23 cents on 3 to 5.5-year-olds.

Total Number of Children Age 0 to 3: 637,682

Total Number of Children Age 3 to K-entry: 575,620

Total Number of Children K-entry & up: 3.16 Million

Expenditures by Source

Total ECE Spending: \$2.08 Billion
Total Federal Spending: \$1.55 Billion
Total State Spending: \$531 Million

Total Expenditures by Age

0 to 3 Spending: \$767 Million
3 to K-entry Spending: \$1.32 Billion
K-12 Spending: \$31 Billion

ECE Expenditures Captured in National Reporting: \$2.02 Billion
Actual State and Federal Expenditures: \$2.08 Billion
