


HAWAII: ECE PUBLIC SPENDING 2022

ECE and K-12

For every dollar spent on K-12 in Hawaii, 6 cents are spent on 0 to 3-year-olds, and 14 cents on 3 to 5.5-year-olds.

Total Number of Children Age 0 to 3: 49,217

Total Number of Children Age 3 to K-entry: 43,068

Total Number of Children K-entry & up: 220,452

0 to 3 Spending: \$43 Million
