


IOWA: ECE PUBLIC SPENDING 2022

ECE and K-12

For every dollar spent on K-12 in Iowa, 9 cents are spent on 0 to 3-year-olds, and 21 cents on 3 to 5.5-year-olds.

Total Number of Children Age 0 to 3: 109,922
Total Number of Children Age 3 to K-entry: 100,036
Total Number of Children K-entry & up: 544,960

Total ECE Spending: \$374 Million

Total Expenditures by Age

0 to 3 Spending: \$116 Million
 3 to K-entry Spending: \$258 Million
