


KANSAS: ECE PUBLIC SPENDING 2022

ECE and K-12

For every dollar spent on K-12 in Kansas, 9 cents are spent on 0 to 3-year-olds, 19 cents on 3 to 5.5-year-olds.

Total Number of Children Age 0 to 3: 103,048
Total Number of Children Age 3 to K-entry: 94,409
Total Number of Children K-entry & up: 525,822

Total ECE Spending: \$368 Million
 Total Federal Spending: \$133 Million
 Total State Spending: \$710 Million

Total Expenditures by Age

0 to 3 Spending: \$126 Million
 3 to K-entry Spending: \$242 Million
 K-12 Spending: \$6.95 Billion

Expenditures Captured in National Reports vs. Actual Expenditures

ECE Expenditures Captured in National Reporting: \$351 Million
 Actual State and Federal Expenditures: \$368 Million
 Difference Not Captured: \$16.6 Million (5%)
