


# MARYLAND: ECE PUBLIC SPENDING 2022

## ECE and K-12

For every dollar spent on K-12 in Maryland, 7 cents are spent on 0 to 3-year-olds, and 20 cents on 3 to 5.5-year-olds.

**Total Number of Children Age 0 to 3: 206,098**  
**Total Number of Children Age 3 to K-entry: 188,911**  
**Total Number of Children K-entry & up: 1 Million**

#### Expenditures by Source

Total ECE Spending: \$820 Million  
 Total Federal Spending: \$440 Million  
 Total State Spending: \$380 Million

#### Total Expenditures by Age

0 to 3 Spending: \$228 Million  
 3 to K-entry Spending: \$592 Million  
 K-12 Spending: \$15.57 Billion

#### Expenditures Captured in National Reports vs. Actual Expenditures

ECE Expenditures Captured in National Reporting: \$717 Million  
 Actual State and Federal Expenditures: \$820 Million  
 Difference Not Captured: \$103 Million (14%)
