


MASSACHUSETTS: ECE PUBLIC SPENDING 2022

ECE and K-12

For every dollar spent on K-12 in Massachusetts, 10 cents are spent on 0 to 3-year-olds, and 15 cents on 3 to 5.5-year-olds.

Per Child Spending by Age Group (2022)



Total Number of Children Age 0 to 3: 207,460

Total Number of Children Age 3 to K-entry: 179,156

Total Number of Children K-entry & up: 1.03 Million

Expenditures by Source

Total ECE Spending: \$946 Million
Total Federal Spending: \$587 Million
Total State Spending: \$360 Million

Total Expenditures by Age

0 to 3 Spending: \$408 Million
3 to K-entry Spending: \$538 Million
K-12 Spending: \$20 Billion

ECE Expenditures Captured in National Reporting: \$707 Billion
Actual State and Federal Expenditures: \$946 Million
Difference Not Captured: \$239 Million (34%)
