


MICHIGAN: ECE PUBLIC SPENDING 2022

ECE and K-12

For every dollar spent on K-12 in Michigan, 8 cents are spent on 0 to 3-year-olds, 23 cents on 3 to 5-year-olds.

Total Number of Children Age 0 to 3: 320,278

Total Number of Children Age 3 to K-entry: 288,755

Total Number of Children K-entry & up: 1.6 Million

Expenditures by Source

Total ECE Spending: \$1.12 Billion
Total Federal Spending: \$638 Million
Total State Spending: \$481 Million

Total Expenditures by Age

0 to 3 Spending: \$353 Million
3 to K-entry Spending: \$887 Billion
K-12 Spending: \$21 Billion
