


MISSOURI: ECE PUBLIC SPENDING 2022

ECE and K-12

For every dollar spent on K-12 in Missouri, 14 cents are spent on 0 to 3-year-olds, and 26 cents on 3 to 5.5-year-olds.

Total Number of Children Age 0 to 3: 210,789

Total Number of Children Age 3 to K-entry: 186,372

Total Number of Children K-entry & up: 1 Million

Total Expenditures by Age

0 to 3 Spending: \$330 Million
