


NEVADA: ECE PUBLIC SPENDING 2022

ECE and K-12

For every dollar spent on K-12 in Nevada, 10 cents are spent on 0 to 3-year-olds, and 10 cents on 3 to 5.5-year-olds.

Total Number of Children Age 0 to 3: 102,059
Total Number of Children Age 3 to K-entry: 94,666
Total Number of Children K-entry & up: 511,274

Total ECE Spending: \$217 Million

Total Expenditures by Age

0 to 3 Spending: \$111 Million
 3 to K-entry Spending: \$106 Million
 K-12 Spending: \$5.50 Billion
