


NEW MEXICO: ECE PUBLIC SPENDING 2022

ECE and K-12

For every dollar spent on K-12 in New Mexico, 25 cents are spent on 0 to 3-year-olds, and 34 cents on 3 to 5.5-year-olds.

Per Child Spending by Age Group (2022)



Total Number of Children Age 0 to 3: 66,612

Total Number of Children Age 3 to K-entry: 61,416

Total Number of Children K-entry & up: 359,640

Expenditures by Source

Total ECE Spending: \$424 Million
Total Federal Spending: \$201 Million
Total State Spending: \$223 Million

Total Expenditures by Age

0 to 3 Spending: \$187 Million
3 to K-entry Spending: \$237 Million
K-12 Spending: \$4.12 Billion

Expenditures Captured in National Reports vs. Actual Expenditures

ECE Expenditures Captured in National Reporting: \$315 Million
Actual State and Federal Expenditures: \$424 Million
Difference Not Captured: \$109 Million (34%)
