


# OREGON: ECE PUBLIC SPENDING 2022

## ECE and K-12

For every dollar spent on K-12 in Oregon, 9 cents are spent on 0 to 3-year-olds, and 19 cents on 3 to 5.5-year-olds.

**Total Number of Children Age 0 to 3: 125,098**  
**Total Number of Children Age 3 to K-entry: 112,705**  
**Total Number of Children K-entry & up: 645,553**

#### Expenditures by Source

Total ECE Spending: \$452 Million  
 Total Federal Spending: \$256 Million  
 Total State Spending: \$195 Million

#### Total Expenditures by Age

0 to 3 Spending: \$154 Million  
 3 to K-entry Spending: \$297.5 Million  
 K-12 Spending: \$8.76 Billion

#### Expenditures Captured in National Reports vs. Actual Expenditures

ECE Expenditures Captured in National Reporting: \$427.6 Million  
 Actual State and Federal Expenditures: \$451.6 Million  
 Difference Not Captured: \$24 Million (6%)
