


RHODE ISLAND: ECE PUBLIC SPENDING 2022

ECE and K-12

For every dollar spent on K-12 in Rhode Island, 9 cents are spent on 0 to 3-year-olds, and 18 cents on 3 to 5.5-year-olds.

Total Number of Children Age 0 to 3: 30,287
Total Number of Children Age 3 to K-entry: 29,461
Total Number of Children K-entry & up: 157,150

Total ECE Spending: \$142 Million

Total Expenditures by Age

0 to 3 Spending: \$49 Million
 3 to K-entry Spending: \$93 Million
 K-12 Spending: \$2.77 Billion

ECE Expenditures Captured in National Reporting: \$129 Million
 Actual State and Federal Expenditures: \$142 Million
