


WYOMING: ECE PUBLIC SPENDING 2022

ECE and K-12

For every dollar spent on K-12 in Wyoming, 9 cents are spent on 0 to 3-year-olds, and 11 cents on 3 to 5.5-year-olds.

Total Number of Children Age 0 to 3: 18,494

Total Number of Children Age 3 to K-entry: 17,283

Total Number of Children K-entry & up: 101,032

Expenditures by Source

Total ECE Spending: \$61 Million
Total Federal Spending: \$52 Million
Total State Spending: \$9.7 Million

Total Expenditures by Age

0 to 3 Spending: \$28.6 Million
3 to K-entry Spending: \$32.7 Million
K-12 Spending: \$1.7 Billion

Expenditures Captured in National Reports vs. Actual Expenditures

ECE Expenditures Captured in National Reporting: \$54 Million
Actual State and Federal Expenditures: \$61.3 Million
Difference Not Captured: \$7.4 Million (14%)
