


ARIZONA: ECE PUBLIC SPENDING 2022

ECE and K-12

For every dollar spent on K-12 in Arizona, 13 cents are spent on 0 to 3-year-olds, and 19 cents on 3 to 5.5-year-olds.

Total Number of Children Age 0 to 3: 231,122
Total Number of Children Age 3 to K-entry: 213,556
Total Number of Children K-entry & up: 1.2 Million

Expenditures by Source

Total ECE Spending: \$682 Million
Total Federal Spending: \$496.2 Million
Total State Spending: \$185.8 Million

Total Expenditures by Age

0 to 3 Spending: \$292.2 Million
3 to K-entry Spending: \$389.8 Million
K-12 Spending: \$11.6 Billion

Expenditures Captured in National Reports vs. Actual Expenditures

ECE Expenditures Captured in National Report: \$523.5 Million
Actual State & Federal Expenditures: \$682 Million
Difference Not Captured: \$158.5 Million (30%)
