


CONNECTICUT: ECE PUBLIC SPENDING 2022

ECE and K-12

For every dollar spent on K-12 in Connecticut, 9 cents are spent on 0 to 3-year-olds, and 15 cents on 3 to 5.5-year-olds.

Total Number of Children Age 0 to 3: 107,934
Total Number of Children Age 3 to K-entry: 94,137
Total Number of Children K-entry & up: 566,651

Total ECE Spending: \$484 Million
Total Federal Spending: \$232 Million
Total State Spending: \$252 Million

Total Expenditures by Age

0 to 3 Spending: \$196.6 Million
3 to K-entry Spending: \$287.4 Million
K-12 Spending: \$11.59 Billion
