


GEORGIA: ECE PUBLIC SPENDING 2022

ECE and K-12

For every dollar spent on K-12 in Georgia, 8 cents are spent on 0 to 3-year-olds, and 21 cents on 3 to 5.5-year-olds.

Total Number of Children Age 3 to K-entry: 341,111
Total Number of Children K-entry & up: 1.9 Million
