


INDIANA: ECE PUBLIC SPENDING 2022

ECE and K-12

For every dollar spent on K-12 in Indiana, 9 cents are spent on 0 to 3-year-olds, and 14 cents on 3 to 5.5-year-olds.

Total Number of Children Age 0 to 3: 240,536

Total Number of Children Age 3 to K-entry: 210,088

Total Number of Children K-entry & up: 1.2 Million

Expenditures by Source

Total ECE Spending: \$544.8 Million

Total State Spending: \$69.6 Million

Total Expenditures by Age

0 to 3 Spending: \$227.8 Million
3 to K-entry Spending: \$317 Million
K-12 Spending: \$12.8 Billion
