


KENTUCKY: ECE PUBLIC SPENDING 2022

ECE and K-12

For every dollar spent on K-12 in Kentucky, 13 cents are spent on 0 to 3-year-olds, and 23 cents on 3 to 5.5-year-olds.

Total Number of Children Age 0 to 3: 154,691

Total Number of Children Age 3 to K-entry: 137,430

Total Number of Children K-entry & up: 749,541

Total ECE Spending: \$614.7 Million

Total State Spending: \$195.8 Million

Total Expenditures by Age

0 to 3 Spending: \$239.6 Million
3 to K-entry Spending: \$375 Million
K-12 Spending: \$8.8 Billion
