


NEBRASKA: ECE PUBLIC SPENDING 2022

ECE and K-12

For every dollar spent on K-12 in Nebraska, 11 cents are spent on 0 to 3-year-olds, and 15 cents on 3 to 5.5-year-olds.

Total Number of Children Age 3 to K-entry: 68,240

Total Number of Children K-entry & up: 354,268
