


NEW HAMPSHIRE: ECE PUBLIC SPENDING 2022

ECE and K-12

For every dollar spent on K-12 in New Hampshire, 7 cents are spent on 0 to 3-year-olds, and 9 cents on 3 to 5.5-year-olds.
