


TEXAS: ECE PUBLIC SPENDING 2022

ECE and K-12

For every dollar spent on K-12 in Texas, 10 cents are spent on 0 to 3-year-olds, and 19 cents on 3 to 5.5-year-olds.

Total Number of Children Age 0 to 3: 1,116,419

Total Number of Children Age 3 to K-entry: 1,002,362

Total Number of Children K-entry & up: 5,497,171

Expenditures by Source

Total ECE Spending: \$3.44 Billion

Total State Spending: \$1.08 Billion

Total Expenditures by Age

0 to 3 Spending: \$1.25 Billion
