


OKLAHOMA: ECE PUBLIC SPENDING 2022

ECE and K-12

For every dollar spent on K-12 in Oklahoma, 16 cents are spent on 0 to 3-year-olds, and 29 cents on 3 to 5.5-year-olds.

Per Child Spending by Age Group (2022)



Total Number of Children Age 0 to 3: 142,950
Total Number of Children Age 3 to K-entry: 130,469
Total Number of Children K-entry & up: 705,353

Expenditures by Source

Total ECE Spending: \$625.2 Million
Total Federal Spending: \$402 Million
Total State Spending: \$223.2 Million

Total Expenditures by Age

0 to 3 Spending: \$235.1 Million
3 to K-entry Spending: \$390.1 Million
K-12 Spending: \$7.3 Billion

Expenditures Captured in National Reports vs. Actual Expenditures

ECE Expenditures Captured in National Report: \$601.1 Million
Actual State & Federal Expenditures: \$625.2 Million
Difference Not Captured: \$24.1 Million (4%)
