


VERMONT: ECE PUBLIC SPENDING 2022

ECE and K-12

For every dollar spent on K-12 in Vermont, 10 cents are spent on 0 to 3-year-olds, and 31 cents on 3 to 5.5-year-olds.

Total Number of Children Age 0 to 3: 16,948
Total Number of Children Age 3 to K-entry: 13,861
Total Number of Children K-entry & up: 91,145

Expenditures by Source

Total ECE Spending: \$132.9 Million

Total State Spending: \$78.8 Million

Total Expenditures by Age

0 to 3 Spending: \$39.1 Million
3 to K-entry Spending: \$93.8 Million
K-12 Spending: \$2 Billion
