

For every dollar spent on K-12-aged students in Indiana, **\$0.09** was spent on infants and toddlers, and **\$0.14** on preschool-aged children.

Indiana invested almost \$569 million in early care and education in 2022, yet only \$519 million of those dollars were reflected in national reports, leaving \$50 million – or 10% – of state and local spending uncaptured.

Of these investments in birth to K-entry:

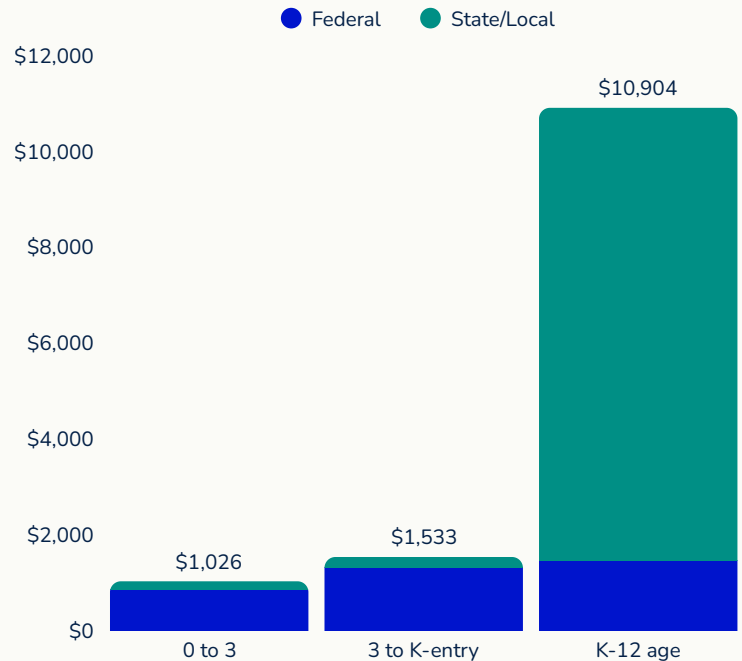
- 43% supported infants and toddlers
- 57% supported children age three to kindergarten entry
- 85% came from federal sources
- 15% came from state funds

In 2022, Indiana supported early care and education through dedicated programs such as On My Way PreK (OMWPK), Healthy Families Indiana, and the Office of Early Childhood and Out-of-School Learning. Continued investments, including rate increases for On My Way PreK, will be reflected in future reports.
