



For every dollar spent on K-12-aged students in Nebraska, **\$0.11 was spent on infants and toddlers, and \$0.15 on preschool-aged children.**

Nebraska invested almost \$238 million in early care and education in 2022, yet only \$216 million of those dollars were reflected in national reports, leaving almost \$22 million – or 10% – of state and local spending uncaptured.

Of these investments in birth to K-entry:

- 44% supported infants and toddlers
 - 71% came from federal sources
 - 29% came from state funds
- 56% supported children age three to kindergarten entry


In 2022, Nebraska supported early care and education through dedicated programs such as the Nebraska Early Childhood Education Program and the Child Care Subsidy Program. Continued investments will be reflected in future reports.
