

For every dollar spent on K-12-aged students in New Jersey, **\$0.10** was spent on infants and toddlers, and **\$0.25** on preschool-aged children.

New Jersey invested over \$2.1 billion in early care and education in 2022, yet only \$1.6 billion of those dollars were reflected in national reports, leaving \$535 million – or 33% – of state and local spending uncaptured.

Of these investments in birth to K-entry:


- 31% supported infants and toddlers
- 69% supported children age three to kindergarten entry
- 28% came from federal sources
- 72% came from state funds

In 2022, New Jersey supported early care and education through dedicated programs such as Work First New Jersey Child Care and Preschool Education Aid (PTRF). Continued investments, such as the Preschool Expansion Program, will be reflected in future reports.
