

For every dollar spent on K-12-aged students in Wisconsin, **\$0.10 was spent on infants and toddlers, and \$0.21 on preschool-aged children.**

Wisconsin invested over \$758 million in early care and education in 2022, yet only \$666 million of those dollars were reflected in national reports, leaving \$92 million – or 14% – of state and local spending uncaptured.

Of these investments in birth to K-entry:

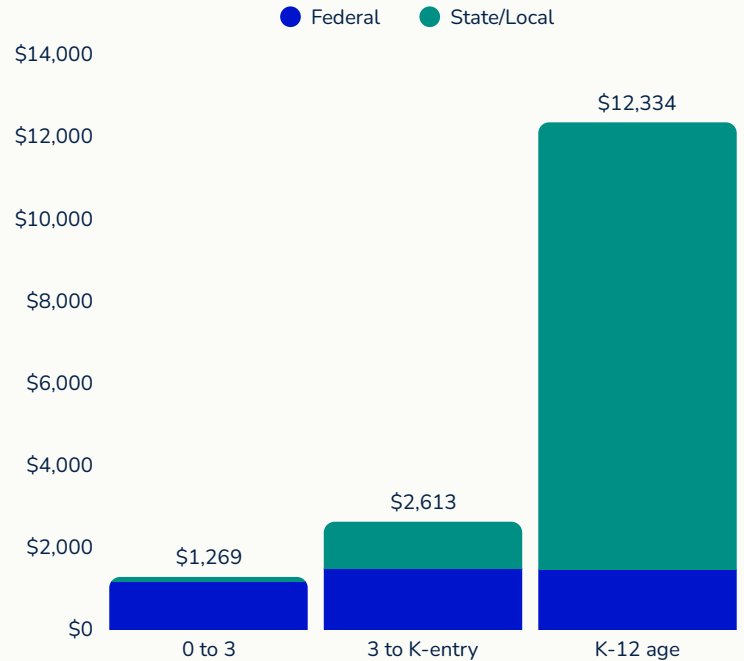
- 37% supported infants and toddlers
- 61% came from federal sources
- 63% supported children age three to kindergarten entry
- 39% came from state funds

In 2022, Wisconsin supported early care and education through dedicated programs such as the Wisconsin Four-Year-Old Kindergarten (4K) program and state contributions to Head Start. Continued investments, such as funding for a statewide screening tool, will be reflected in future reports.
